Interactive Wheels



Desktop Wheel

This is the primary eBeam wheel displayed when you first launch eBeam Interact. You can use it to launch tools and applications. Open the Scrapbook, launch Powerpoint and quickly calibrate!



Scrapbook Wheel

This is the eBeam wheel displayed when using Scrapbook. It gives you the tools to annotate and perform interactive activities easily. Plus this wheel is customizable.



Annotation Wheel

This is the wheel used in annotation mode. Even outside the scrapbook you can quickly make a note, correction, hold an impromptu meeting and one button save.
